ORACLE AND TEILHARD REACH CROSS-LICENSE AGREEMENT

Calgary, AB, Canada and Redwood Shores, CA (February 9, 2007) -- Oracle Corporation and Teilhard Technologies announced today that the companies have entered into a patent cross-license agreement. The agreement encompasses multiple patents related to data extraction, transformation, and loading (“ETL”).

“This agreement between Oracle and Teilhard is a positive milestone for all of our stakeholders – shareholders, employees, customers and partners,” said Ken Prather, CEO of Teilhard. “Forward looking, our leading product suite could have broad distribution networks with one of the largest business enterprise software companies in the world, which would elevate the visibility of our solutions to new levels within the enterprise content management industry.”

The cross-license agreement stems from the amicable resolution of two declaratory judgment actions that Oracle had filed against Teilhard in the United States District Courts for the Northern District of California (Case No. C 06-02889 SI) and the District of Columbia (Case No. 1:06CV01810). The suits involved Teilhard’s United States Patent No. 6,195,662, for a system for transforming and exchanging data between distributed heterogeneous computer systems. The settlement includes a cash payment to Teilhard and the cross-licensing of several patents. The specific terms of the settlement are confidential.

ETL technology is often used when sharing data among computer systems supporting different data formats. A common application of ETL technology is the movement of data from old “legacy” computer systems to modern data warehouses.

Oracle and Teilhard are continuing to engage in discussions regarding possible joint technical and sales opportunities, initially focused within the Canadian government sector. This ongoing initiative relates to potential synergies for Teilhard’s state of the art object oriented integration solutions and Oracle’s industry-leading business applications, with a goal of providing significant competitive advantages in the real-time integration of all data sources, driving enterprise level workflow performance to new levels.

“This agreement brings Oracle’s dispute with Teilhard to a successful conclusion and opens the door to cooperative initiatives going forward that will benefit both companies, as well as their current and prospective customers,” said Oracle Chief Patent Counsel Roger Kennedy.
